PRIVACY POLICY

§ 1

[general information]

1. The website sizeisjustanumber.com (“Website”) is managed by Monika Jurczyk operating as a sole trader under the business name: Monika Jurczyk OSA Osobista Stylistka, ul. Mickiewicza 26/98, 46-320 Praszka, NIP (Tax Identification Number): 5761452882, entered in the Business Activity Central Register and Information Record, e-mail: contact@personalstylist.pl (“Controller”).
2. The Controller may collect, process and use the Users’ information provided through our Website.
3. Users’ information which may be collected include: data provided on a voluntary basis (e.g.: when ordering products, via the contact form) and contained in the cookies – both our own and coming from external entities.
4. We may also collect information about the User’s IP address, the time of request and response, the address of the website which redirected the User to our Website and the type of software used. These data are used for the purpose of the Website administration, statistics and analyses.

§ 2

[personal data]

1. The personal data controller is Monika Jurczyk operating as a sole trader under the business name: Monika Jurczyk OSA Osobista Stylistka, ul. Mickiewicza 26/98, 46-320 Praszka, NIP (Tax Identification Number): 5761452882, entered in the Business Activity Central Register and Information Record, e-mail: contact@personalstylist.pl.
2. Personal data shall be processed in accordance with the provisions of applicable law and, in particular, in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016. (“GDPR”).
3. The Users’ data shall be processed for the purpose of:
 - the due performance of a sales contract, i.e.: a contract to which the data subject is a party (Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR);
 - sending a newsletter or a free e-book by e-mail, if the User has agreed to receive commercial information or a free e-book in accordance with separate regulations (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR);
 - contacting Users who have used the contact form (Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR).

4. Personal data may be shared with entities that process the data on the Controller's behalf, such as:
 - providers of the IT services and systems used by the Controller;
 - providers of accounting services;
 - providers of IT support services.
5. Personal data may be made available to entities that provide the User with delivery services with regard to the purchased product.
6. In relation to the electronic payments, personal data may be disclosed to the entity providing payment services, i.e.: PayU Spółka Akcyjna with its registered office in Poznań at ul. Grunwaldzka 186, 60-166 Poznań.
7. Personal data processed in order to:
 - perform the sales contract – shall be stored by the Controller for a period of 10 years of the sales contract date or until the statute of limitations on claims arising from that contract expires;
 - send the newsletter – shall be processed by the Controller until the data subject objects or withdraw their consent to receive commercial communications;
 - contact Users who have used the contact form – shall be processed by the Controller for a period of 3 years of the data collection date;
8. When processing personal data, the Controller may use the services of entities based in the USA. Consequently, personal data may be transferred outside the European Economic Area. The Controller declares that, if this is the case, it will only use the services of entities that joined the Privacy Shield programme and ensure an adequate level of data protection.
9. The data subject shall have the following rights:
 - the right to access to the personal data provided and the right to obtain a copy thereof;
 - the right to rectification of the personal data;
 - the right to erasure of the personal data (“right to be forgotten”);
 - the right to restriction of processing of the personal data;
 - the right to data portability;
 - the right to object to processing of the personal data;
 - the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
10. In order to exercise any of the rights referred to above, the data subject shall contact the Controller.
11. The Controller shall ensure the protection of the personal data they process. In particular, the Controller shall apply appropriate technical safeguards and organisational measures to ensure the protection of personal data processed, appropriate to the risks and to the category of data protected. In particular, the Controller shall protect the data from being made available to unauthorised persons, from being taken by an unauthorised person, from being processed in breach of the Act, and from being altered, lost, damaged or destroyed.

12. Providing personal data is voluntary, but it is a condition for entering into a sales contract, receiving a newsletter, receiving a free e-book or contacting the Controller.

§ 3

[cookies]

1. The Website uses cookies stored on the Users' devices. The use of cookies shall mean storing and accessing them by the Controller.
2. Cookies shall be used on the Website upon Users' consent. The Controller informs that in accordance with the provisions of the Telecommunications Act, the consent of the end User to store information or to access information already stored in the end User's telecommunications device may also be expressed by the User through software settings installed therein. Therefore, should the User not wish to give such consent, they should change their browser settings.
3. The User may delete cookies each time they finish using the Website, they may also limit or completely disable the storing of cookies in the memory of their devices through appropriate settings of their Internet browser.
4. Detailed information on how to change the browser's cookie settings and how to delete them can be found on the official website of the relevant browser. In particular, the above information can be found at the following web browsers:
 - Firefox;
 - Chrome;
 - Microsoft Edge;
 - Opera;
 - Safari.
5. Restrictions introduced by the User on the use of cookies may hamper or limit the full functionality of the Website.
6. In the course of providing services, the Controller uses:
 - temporary cookies, which are deleted once Users have finished using the Website (closing the page),
 - persistent cookies, which remain in the memory of the device for a limited period of time and are used every time Users access the Website.
7. The Controller uses the following types of cookies:
 - cookies which enable Users to make use of the functionalities of the Website – in particular to ensure that Users can log in and maintain their session and order products;
 - cookies for secure shopping – to enable the User to place secure orders;
 - cookies which allow to the Controller to remember the individual settings the User has chosen for the Website;
 - statistics cookies used for collecting statistical data by the Controller;

- advertising cookies which make it possible to provide Users with advertising content tailored to their interests.
8. The Controller uses IT tools in the form of Google Analytics and Google Adwords.
 9. Google Analytics uses cookie technology to enable the Controller to analyse the sources of traffic and how visitors use it.
 10. Google AdWords uses cookie technology to enable the Controller to evaluate the correctness and effectiveness of advertising activities carried out using the AdWords network.
 11. Google collects the data generated from cookies placed on the User's device and uses this information to compile reports and to provide other services relating to traffic and the use of the Internet. Google may also transfer this information to third parties if required to do so by law, or if such third parties process the information on Google's behalf. If the User does not agree to the placing of cookies on their device, they may block the placement by configuring the web browser accordingly. Information on how to do this can be found in the help files of every web browser. If the Google cookies are blocked, the Controller cannot guarantee the correct operation of the Website.
 12. The Controller allows other entities to use cookies on its websites. These include entities providing so-called social plug-ins, in particular Facebook. The Controller may place on the Website "Like" and "Recommend"/"Share" buttons linked to Facebook. For this purpose, a code referring to Facebook is inserted in the relevant sections and pages. By using the appropriate button, the User logs on to Facebook, which is governed by Facebook's privacy policy. These regulations are available at <http://pl-pl.facebook.com/help/cookies>.
